LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1944.

ENTITLED AN ACT creating the position of LINEMAN HELPER  
AND STOCK CLERK in the Municipal Lighting Department of the City  
of Plattsburgh, New York, prescribing the duties of such position  
and providing for the classification and compensation thereof.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Platts-  
burgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Creation and Classification. There shall be in the  
Municipal Lighting Department of the City of Plattsburgh, New York,  
a Lineman Helper and Stock Clerk, which position shall be classified  
in the Municipal Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh, New York,  
in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>Class Title.</u>	<u>Jurisdictional Title.</u>
Lineman Helper and Stock Clerk.	Competitive.

SECTION 2. Duties. Lineman helper and stock clerk shall  
perform the following duties: Assist in digging holes for power  
poles and in setting and equipping poles. Assist in splicing  
cables. Supplies lineman with materials, tools, equipment and  
devices. Loads and unloads equipment trucks. Drive line truck  
and operate a winch and derrick when required. Records time of  
line truck and crew according to the jobs assigned. Maintains  
material inventories on truck, safety kits and equipment. Receives  
and returns all material from stockroom to trucks.

SECTION 3. Maximum and minimum compensation and rate of in-  
crease. The holder of the position created by Section 1 of the Act  
shall be compensated as follows: Column 1 the minimum compensation  
or entrance salary; Column 2 the maximum compensation and Column  
3 shows the rate of yearly increase until the maximum is reached.

SECTION 4. Vacations and sick leave. The provisions of  
Section 13 of Local Law No. 7 of 1943 shall apply with full force  
and effect to the person holding the position created by Section  
1 of this Act.

SECTION 5. Vacancies and temporary appointments. The pro-  
visions of Sections 5 and 6 of Local Law No. 5 of 1942 shall apply  
with full force and effect to the person holding the position  
created by Section 1 of this Act.

SECTION 6. Time of taking effect. This Local Law shall take  
effect immediately after public hearing has been had thereon and  
approval by the Mayor.
