LOCAL LAW NO. 6 of 1956.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Local Law No. 5, of 1956, fixing the Compensation for the position of City Chamberlain/

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Local Law No. 5 of 1956 is hereby amended, insofar as it relates to the salary of the City Chamberlain to read as follows:


The salary of the City Chamberlain, upon appointment, shall be at the rate of \$5,000.00 for each Calendar Year, which annual rate shall be increased \$200.00 at the beginning of each successive service year until the maximum amount of the annual salary rate of \$6,000.00 is attained.

Section 2. Time of Taking Effect. This Act shall be in effect on and after November 2nd, 1956, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Brault, Villoni, Jabaut, Corodimas and Flynn voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
