A local law AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 253 - FRONT YARD PARKING

of Plattsburgh as follows:

1. Chapter 253 Article 2 is amended to add the following:
 - a. Front Yard. A yard situated between a building on a lot and the street line or, where the lot is unimproved, between the front yard setback line and the street line. Where a lot is a corner lot, the yards on both streets shall be considered front yards.
 - b. Setback Line – A line within the bounds of a lot parallel to a property line at a distance from the respective property line equaling the respective required front, rear or side yard as defined in City Code Chapter 270.

2. Chapter 253 Article 6 is amended to add the following:

6.8 Front Yards. In R-1 and R-H districts or OL-P Districts as established under Chapter 270 of the City Code, no motor vehicle shall be parked in the front yard of any lot, except on a paved driveway or an approved, paved parking area.

Schedule I --- FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF CHAPTER 253

6.8	Front Yard	\$50.00	\$1.50 per day

The City Clerk is directed to provide a certified copy of this local law with proof of the of filing with the Secretary of State to the City Police Department and Chief Clerk, City Court promptly upon confirmation of filing with the Secretary of State, and the City Clerk is directed to request the City Court Judge to sign an Order approving the amount of the fine and penalty authorized by this local law.
5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Mayor and filing with the Secretary of State.




