LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1970

ENTITLED AN ACT providing for the compensation, rate of increase, and time of taking effect of such increases for various City Personnel.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION I. COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES INCLUDED

IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSIFICATIONS

C. Employees who work in job classifications included in this section shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. LONGEVITY

- (A) Upon anniversary date of completion of five (5) years of continuous employment, employees covered by this agreement shall receive longevity service pay in the form of an hourly increase, which increase shall for each year of employment thereafter be in the aggregate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- (B) Upon the completion of each additional multiple of five (5) years continuous service, the employee shall receive an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in the manner provided in (A) above.
- (C) No employee, who on the effective date of this Local Law, has been receiving a greater amount of longevity pay on the system provided for in Local Law No. 12 of 1968 shall suffer a diminution of pay.

SECTION I C.

2. RETROACTIVITY.

- (A) Upon this Local Law becoming effective, the wage rates provided in this Section shall be retroactive to January 1, 1970, wherever legally permissible.
- (B) The retroactive pay shall be computed and paid on the basis of 35 hours for the classification listed in Subdivision A above, and 40 hours for the classifications in Subdivision B above, for each pay period the employee worked.

SECTION 2 COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES:

Inspectors of election and other election officers entitled to be appointed shall receive compensation which is hereby fixed as follows: Primary day -\$20.00; each registration day - \$20.00; and General Election Day - \$25.00; Party Representatives for Elections entitled to be appointed shall receive \$15.00 for Election Day; Custodians of voting machines shall receive \$500.00 for their services for each calendar year.

SECTION 3 SUPERSESSON

Provisions of all acts inconsistent with this act are hereby superseded.

SECTION 4 TIME OF TAKING EFFECT

This act shall be in effect on and after October 29, 1970, or January 1, 1970, as hereinbefore set forth, after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Burke, Branon and Akey voted in the affirmative; Alderman Ianelli voting in the negative; (Aldermen King and Ryan being absent) NOT CARRIED.
