LOCAL LAW NO. 13 of 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 153 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 providing for the issuance of tax receipts.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 153 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 153-- Tax Receipts. Immediately upon receipt of any taxes the Chamberlain shall enter in a column upon the tax roll, provided for that purpose and opposite the name of the person or corporation paying the same, the fact of payment and the date thereof and give the person paying the same a receipt therefor. The form and contents of said receipt shall be fixed and determined by the said City Chamberlain. All taxes or assessments paid within 30 days from the due date of the first installment of taxes, or installments of taxes paid within 30 days of the due date of each installment of taxes, shall be payable without fee, percentage or interest thereon. On all installments of taxes or assessments remaining unpaid after the expiration of such 30 days after the due date of each installment the City Chamberlain shall collect interest at the rate of one per centum per month from the expiration of said 30 days, which percentage and interest shall belong to the City

Section 2. Laws Repealed. Local Law No. 4 of 1932 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Time of Taking Effect.- This act shall take effect immediately upon public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
