On an annual basis, the City tracks and submits to NYS total expenditures and total volumes of gasoline, diesel fuel, fuel oil, natural gas, electricity, coal, and propane used in City operations. The figures submitted are comprehensive and reflect all relevant billings processed by the City's Finance Department. A copy of the City's 2021 energy costs and consumption report is included with this addendum for reference.
