LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1956

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE CORPORATION COUNSEL, CITY JUDGE, AND ACTING CITY JUDGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Compensation of Corporation Counsel</u>. The salary of the Corporation Counsel shall be the sum of \$5200.00 per year, commencing February 1st, 1956, to be paid in the same manner as other City salaries are paid.

Section 2. <u>Compensation of City Judge</u>. The salary of the City Judge shall be the sum of \$5,000.00 per year commencing February 1st, 1956, to be paid in the same manner as other City salaries are paid.

Section 3. Compensation of Acting City Judge. The compensation of the Acting City Judge shall be the sum of \$12.00 per sitting, not to exceed the sum of \$720.00 per year.

Section 4. Laws Superceded. All Local Laws inconsistent with this Act are hereby superceded.

Section 5. This Act shall take effect February 1st, 1956, after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Brault, Villoni, Jabaut, and Flynn voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, (Alderman Corodimas being absent) CARRIED.
