LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1982

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH TO SIGN CHECKS WITH FACSIMILE SIGNATURE.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

SECTION 1:

SECTION 1.

The Mayor of the City of Plattsburgh, New York may sign checks with the facsimile signature of the Mayor as reproduced by a machine or a device commonly known as a check signer.

SECTION 2.

Any provisions of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, Local Law or Ordinances inconsistent with this law are repealed.
