LOCAL LAW NO. 11 OF 1964

A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION OF ELECTRICIAN IN THE MUNICIPAL
LIGHTING DEPARTMENT, CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, IN THE COMPETITIVE CLASS OF
THE MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE, PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF HIS APPOINT-
MENT, AND FIXING THE SALARY THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK.

SECTION 1. CREATION OF POSITION. THERE SHALL BE IN THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING
DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, AN ELECTRICIAN, WHICH POSITION SHALL BE
IN THE COMPETITIVE CLASS OF THE MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE.

SECTION 2. THE ELECTRICIAN SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR, SUBJECT TO
CONFIRMATION BY THE COMMON COUNCIL. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF
SECTION 10 OF CHAPTER 269 OF THE LAWS OF 1902, THE CONCURRENCE OF THREE ALDERMEN
SHALL BE DEEMED A CONFIRMATION.


SECTION 3. SALARY. THE SALARY OF SAID ELECTRICIAN SHALL BE AT THE MINIMUM
RATE OF \$3.01 PER HOUR AND A MAXIMUM RATE OF \$3.35 PER HOUR, PAYABLE IN THE SAME
MANNER AS THAT OF OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT, CITY OF
PLATTSBURGH AND IN ADDITION IT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF LOCAL LAW
NO. 6 OF 1964.

SECTION 4. VACATIONS AND SICK LEAVE. THE PROVISIONS OF LOCAL LAW NO. 6
OF 1964 SHALL APPLY WITH FULL FORCE AND EFFECT TO THE PERSON HOLDING THE POSITION
CREATED BY SECTION 1 OF THIS ACT.


SECTION 5. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT. THIS ACT WILL TAKE EFFECT AFTER A PUBLIC
HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.
