

Local Law No. 4 . Int. April 27, 1925.

An Act to Supersede Section 72 of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, in relation to appointment and salary of the officers and members of the Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, as follows:-

Sec. 1. Section 72 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the City of Plattsburgh", as last amended by Chapter 583 of the Laws of 1915 is hereby superseded to read as follows:

Section 72. Appointment of Officers and Members of Fire Department. The chief engineer, assistant engineer, and other paid members of the Fire Department shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject as hereinbefore provided to the approval of the Common Council. The salary of the chief engineer of the Fire Department shall be such a sum not exceeding fifteen (twelve) hundred dollars per annum, payable monthly as may be fixed ^{by} the Common Council. The salaries of all the other members of the paid Fire Department shall be fixed by the Common Council.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
