LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1932.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 151 of the City Charter
of the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y., being part of Chapter 269
of the Laws of 1902 of the State of New York, specifying the
time for the delivery of the assessment roll with taxes
apportioned and extended thereon, to the Chamberlain for
collection.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the
City of Plattsburgh, N.Y., that Section 151 of the City
Charter shall be superseded by the following:

SECTION 151: Issue of tax roll and warrant to chamberlain:
The City Clerk under direction of the Common Council shall
extend and apportion the taxes to be collected on the assessment
roll delivered to him and as previously certified by the Board
of Assessors of the City. He shall make one copy of said
assessment roll and shall forthwith file the same in his
office. Upon completion of the apportionments and extensions
on the original assessment roll, the same shall then be pre-
sented to the Common Council for approval and ~~delivery shall~~
~~then be presented to the Common Council for approval and~~
delivery to the City Chamberlain with warrant signed by the
Mayor and City Clerk, commanding him (Her) to receive and
collect the several sums specified as assessed against the
person or property therein mentioned or described, with
such percentage or penalty and interest hereinafter provided
in the manner provided by law for the collection and
levying of county taxes by town collectors with the additional
powers conferred by this Act. Said assessment roll and
first warrant to be issued thereon shall be delivered to the
Chamberlain on or before March 1, 1932 and in each succeeding
year thereafter on or before the first day of February, or
as soon thereafter as practicable. A second warrant shall
be issued on said annual assessment roll as provided by
Section 150 of the City Charter, as amended by Local Law No.
1 of 1932, that is, not later than August 1st in any one
year. From the time of the receipt of the tax roll and
warrants by the chamberlain, all taxes assessed and levied
upon any real estate shall be a lien upon such real estate for
the amount thereof with percentage and interest until the
same shall be fully paid.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon
approval.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, Roach, Raymond, Light,
Spearman and Shay voted in the affirmative; no one in the
negative; CARRIED.
