LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1972

AN ACT PROVIDING for the compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increases for certain City employees.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION I: COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES INCLUDED IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSIFICATION.

SECTION 2. The City employee in the position listed in Section 1A above shall be subject to the following conditions.

A. 1. The first Column shows the entrance or minimum compensation.

(a) Under special conditions and subject to the approval of the approval of the Mayor, new appointments can be made at amounts shown under Column 2 or Column 3 when such action is determined to be in the best interest of the City.

2. Column 2 shows the compensation to which the City employees are entitled to upon completion of one (1) year of continuous service with the City of Plattsburgh.

3. The third column shows the maximum amount the City employees are entitled to upon completion of five (5) years of continuous service with the City of Plattsburgh.

4. The fourth column shows the increment which shall be added to the appropriate salary rate of the City Employees upon completion of each multiple of five (5) years of continuous service with the City of Plattsburgh, as shown in Column 5 through 8.

SECTION 3: SUPERSESSION.

Provisions of all acts inconsistent with this act are hereby superseded.

SECTION 4. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT.

This act shall be in effect on and after June 15, 1972 after Public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Burke, Dame, Branon, Rennell, Griffin and Poitras voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; CARRIED.
