## LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1931.

Entitled An Act to Amend and Supersede Section 31 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y." as last amended by Chapter 428 of the Laws of 1912.

By Alderman Holland, Seconded by Alderman George Bourdeau.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y., that Section 31 (City Charter) be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 31. CITY ASSESSORS. The city assessors shall perform all the duties regired of them by this act in relation to the assessment of property in said city as well as for the purpose of imposing taxes levied by the board of supervisors of Clinton County as those levied by the Common Council of said city and to that end they shall perform all the duties and possess all the power and authority of town assessors except as modified by this act. They are hereby authorized to employ some competent person, who may be one of the assessors, to do the clerical work in making said assessment roll but the expense to the city for that purpose shall not exceed fifty dollars in any one year. They are also authorized to expend a sum not to exceed fifty dollars in any one year for the purpose of providing such transportation in and about the City of Flattsburgh, N.Y. as the performance of their duties may require.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon approval.

On roll call Aldermen Holland, Brault, Lamar, Wallace Bourdeau, Spearman and George Bourdeau voted in the affirmative. No one in the negative.

CARRIED.

The above Local Law is hereby approved after Public Hearing held this 29th day of July, 1931.
