LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1958

ENTITLED AN ACT CLASSIFYING TITLES AND POSITIONS
AND PROVIDING FOR THE MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM COMPENSATION,
RATE OF ANNUAL INCREMENTS, AND TIME OF TAKING EFFECT OF
SUCH INCREMENTS FOR VARIOUS CITY PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS

THE ANNUAL SALARY RATES OF THE FOLLOWING CITY OFFICIALS AND PERSONNEL SHALL BE THE AMOUNTS SHOWN BELOW:

ALDERMEN	\$1350.	MAYOR	\$9000.
CITY JUDGE	\$5512.	CORPORATION COUNSEL	\$5772.

THE SALARY OF THE ACTING CITY JUDGE SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$13.50 PER DAY FOR EACH DAY FOR WHICH HE SITS, BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$810.00 IN ANY TERM YEAR.

SUPERVISORS AND CONSTABLES SHALL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE SAME COMPENSATION FOR THEIR SERVICES AS CORRESPONDING OFFICERS IN THE TOWNS OF THE COUNTY OF CLINTON ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FOR LIKE SERVICES.

INSPECTORS OF ELECTION AND OTHER ELECTION OFFICERS ENTITLED TO BE APPOINTED SHALL RECEIVE COMPENSATION WHICH IS HEREBY FIXED AS FOLLOWS: PRIMARY DAY - \$15.00; EACH REGISTRATION DAY - \$15.00; AND GENERAL ELECTION DAY - \$15.00; PARTY REPRESENTATIVES FOR ELECTIONS ENTITLED TO BE APPOINTED SHALL RECEIVE \$10.00 FOR ELECTION DAY; CUSTODIANS OF VOTING MACHINES SHALL RECEIVE \$100.00 FOR THEIR SERVICES FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR.

SECTION 2. COMPENSATION OF OTHER CITY PERSONNEL

THE SALARIES OF ALL OTHER CITY PERSONNEL SHALL BE ACCORDING TO THE CLASSIFICATION AND GRADES CONTAINED IN THE SCHEDULES WHICH ARE ANNEXED HERETO AND HEREBY MADE A PART OF THIS SECTION; EXCEPT THAT FOR THE POSITIONS LISTED BELOW, THE ANNUAL SALARY RATES AND EFFECTIVE DATES SHALL BE ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE UNTIL THE MAXIMUM SALARY RATES ARE ATTAINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT:

ALL OF WHICH SHALL BE PAYABLE FROM APPROPRIATIONS ACCORDING TO THE DEPARTMENT, ACTIVITY OR PROJECT FOR WHICH THE LABOR WAS PERFORMED.

LABORERS AND OTHER PART-TIME AND/OR SEASONAL PERSONNEL EMPLOYED BY THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT SHALL RECEIVE WAGES AT THE FOLLOWING RATES:

SECTION 3. INCREMENTS

EACH OFFICIAL, DEPARTMENT HEAD AND EMPLOYEE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ONE ANNUAL INCREMENT EACH YEAR UP TO THE MAXIMUM OF THE GRADE IN WHICH HIS POSITION IS ALLOCATED

EACH OFFICIAL, DEPARTMENT HEAD AND EMPLOYEE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ADDITIONAL STEP INCREMENTS UPON COMPLETION OF TEN, FIFTEEN AND TWENTY YEARS IN THE SAME POSITION; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SUCH LONGEVITY INCREMENTS SHALL NOT COMMENCE UNTIL THE FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING THE ONE DURING WHICH SUCH PERSONNEL IS PAID THE MAXIMUM SALARIES FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT. NO ONE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO MORE THAN ONE INCREMENT STEP DURING ANY FISCAL YEAR.

SECTION 4. PART-TIME AND TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT

THE COMMON COUNCIL, OR ANY OTHER OFFICER WHO MAY BE SO AUTHORIZED OR EMPOWERED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, MAY EMPLOY PERSONS ON A PART-TIME OR TEMPORARY BASIS TO PERFORM ANY OF THE DUTIES OF THE POSITIONS LISTED IN THIS ACT.

SECTION 5. LEGAL HOLIDAYS

CITY EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED ON AN HOURLY BASIS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO WORK ON A DAY DESIGNATED FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF A LEGAL HOLIDAY, SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS EXCEPTED, SHALL, IN ADDITION TO A DAY'S WAGES FOR SUCH HOLIDAY, BE ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION FOR THE NUMBER OF HOURS ACTUALLY WORKED AT THEIR USUAL HOURLY RATE AS ESTABLISHED HEREIN.

SECTION 6. SUPERCESSION

PROVISIONS OF ALL ACTS INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ACT ARE HEREBY SUPERCEDED.


SECTION 7. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT

THIS ACT SHALL BE IN EFFECT ON AND AFTER SEPTEMBER 18, 1958, AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.


