LOCAL LAW NO. 3 of 1967

By Alderman Duken; seconded by Alderman King:

A LOCAL LAW CREATING THE POSITION OF CARPENTER-MASON IN THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the position of Carpenter-Mason which shall be in the non-competitive class of the classified Civil Service of the City of Plattsburgh.

SECTION 2. The said Carpenter-Mason shall perform such duties as may be assigned to him by the Mayor and the Common Council within the scope of the duties adopted by the Municipal Civil Service Commission and approved by the New York State Civil Service Commission.

SECTION 3. The salary of such Carpenter-Mason shall be fixed by the Common Council and the provisions of all Laws, Ordinances, or Resolutions relating to vacations, sick leaves and to accident and health insurance shall apply.


SECTION 4. This act shall take effect after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
