LOCAL LAW NO.30 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT adding Section 45H to Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 45H is hereby added to Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, the same to read as follows:

Lien of. - Every tax and assessment imposed under any of the provisions of this title shall be a lien upon all real estate against which the same shall be assessed, for ten years from the filing of such assessment roll, superior to any mortgage, judgment or other lien of any nature, except general city and school tax affecting the same and shall have priority thereto, pr to any conveyance thereon, and notice to the occupant or tenant shall be held to be deemed a notice to the owner or owners of said real estate.

SECTION 2. Laws Repealed. Section 69 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 and all acts amendatory thereto are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
