LOCAL LAW NO 39 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 93 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended by Section 449 of the Laws of 1963 and all acts amendatory thereof and in this instance regarding the method of payment of salaries of police officers.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 93 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as amended by Section 449 of the Laws of 1903 and all acts amendatory thereof is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 93. Payment of Salaries and Expenses.

The salaries of the members of the police force shall be paid in a manner to be directed by the Common Council and the contingent expenses of the police department for rent telephone, expenses for office furniture, fuel, light, stationery, printing, advertising, badges and batons and other necessary expenses shall be certified by the Mayor, and when audited by the Common Council, shall be paid by the Chamberlain of said city upon warrant of the Mayor and countersigned by the Clerk.

SECTION 2. Laws Repealed. All local laws inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
