

Regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of
Plattsburgh, New York, held December 30, 1938:

By Alderman HOLLAND; seconded by Alderman O'CONNELL:

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 of 1938, Entitled
An Act to Amend Section I of Local Law No.
2 of 1924, in relation to the salaries of
certain officers and employees of the City
of Plattsburgh, providing for in this instance,
an increase in the salary of the City Judge from
\$1200.00 per annum to \$1500.00 per annum, effective
January 1st, 1939.


BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of
Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 2 of Local Law No. 2 of
1924 be amended in part as follows:-

That the salary of the City Judge be and the same is hereby
fixed by the Common Council at \$1500.00 per annum, which salary
shall be paid only out of an appropriation to be set up each year
in the Police Fund of the Annual City Budget for such purpose.


The above amendment to become effective as of January 1, 1939.
