

Regular Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, held May 1st, 1942.

PRESENT: Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Giolosa, Demary, Behan and Tyrell.

ABSENT: Mayor Bouyea; Alderman Holland presiding as Acting Mayor.

By Alderman Holland; seconded by Alderman Behan:

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, being part of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 of the State of New York, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1926, Local Law No. 3 of 1927, Local Law No. 2 of 1933, Local Law No. 4 of 1939, Local Law No. 5 of 1939, and Local Law No. 7 of 1939, providing in this instance for the fixing of the salaries of the members of the Police Department and the Fire Department.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that the provisions of Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, being Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 of the State of New York, as amended by the local laws above mentioned, and with reference to the salaries of the members of the Police Department and the First Department mentioned therein, that the following shall replace the provisions thereof in relation to the salaries of the members of the Police Department and the Fire Department.

Section 1. Members of the Police Department.

Effective January 1st, 1942, the salary of the Chief of Police and/or Acting Chief of Police shall be the sum of \$2560.00 per annum; the salary of the Sergeant of Police shall be the sum of \$1860.00 per annum and the salary of each Regular Patrolman, upon appointment, shall be the sum of \$1600.00 for the first year, which sum shall be increased at the rate of \$100.00 per year until each Regular Patrolman shall receive the sum of \$1800.00 per annum.

Each and every member of the Police Department who shall have served more than two years at the time of the enactment of this Act shall be entitled to the maximum pay provided for herein, and each member who has served less than two years at the time of the enactment of this legislation shall be entitled to the pay provided for in this Act, according to his term of service.

Section 2. Members of the Fire Department.


Effective January 1st, 1942, the salary of the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department shall be the sum of \$2100.00 per annum; the salary of the Assistant Chief Engineer of Fire shall be \$1860.00 per annum; and the salary of each Regular Fireman on appointment shall be the sum of \$1600.00 for the first year, and the same shall be increased at the rate of \$100.00 per year until each Regular Fireman shall receive the sum of \$1800.00 per annum.

Each and every member of the Fire Department who shall have served more than two years at the time of the enactment of this Act, shall be entitled to the maximum pay provided for herein, and each member who has served less than two years at the time of the enactment of this legislation, shall be entitled to the pay provided for in this Act, according to his term of service.


