LOCAL LAW NUMBER 6 OF 1932.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 158 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, being part of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 of the State of New York, as amended by Chapter 428 of the Laws of 1912, providing for the sale of lands for unpaid taxes.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 158 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as amended by Chapter 428 of the Laws of 1912, be superseded by the following:

Whenever any such tax, water charges, appearing on current assessment roll for the year 1932 and each year thereafter, penalty or interest, or any part of either of them, shall remain unpaid on the first day of November, the chamberlain shall proceed, after the receipt of the assessor's, or assessors' statement to be furnished said chamberlain in accordance with the provisions of Section 15% of the City Charter, to advertise and sell the lands upon which the same was imposed, for the payment of such tax, expenses of survey and advertising, penalty or interest, or the part remaining unpaid, and the expenses of such sale, as hereinafter prescribed, shall also be a charge upon such lands.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon

approval.
On roll call Aldermen Holland, Roach, Raymond, Light,
Spearman and Shay voted in the affirmative. No one in the negative.
