## LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1941.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Local Law No. 2 of 1930 and by such amendment to provide for an increase in the salary for the City Chamberlain from \$1,500.00 per annum to \$1,600.00 per annum.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Platts-burgh, New York, that Local Law No. 2 of 1930 amending Local Law No. 2 of 1924, Local Law No. 1 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1926, Local Law No. 3 of 1927, and superseding certain provisions of said Law and provisions inconsistent herewith of Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as Numbered by Legislative Act of the Laws of 1902, be and the same is hereby amended, and that the said Local Law No. 2 of 1930 as so amended to be superseded by the following:

SECTION 1. Salaries. The Salary of the Acting Chief of Police shall be Twenty-One Hundred Dollars per annum; the Salary of the Sergeant of Police shall be Sixteen Hundred and Sixty Dollars per annum; the Salary of Regular Patrolmen on appointment shall be Fifteen Hundred Dollars per annum and shall increase Fifty Dollars after the first year and Fifty Dollars after the second year; that the Salary of Patrolmen having served two years or more shall be Sixteen Hundred Dollars per annum, and that the above salaries shall become effective September 1, 1930. The Salary of the Commissioner of Public Welfare shall be as provided for by Local Law No. 7 of 1939. The Salary of the City Chamberlain shall be \$1,600.00 per annum - \$550.00 of which shall be chargeable to and paid out of the General Fund and \$750.00 shall be chargeable to and paid out of the Water Fund for the Chamberlain's service to the Water Department.

FURTHER ENACTED, that Section 11 of the City Charter as amended by Local Law No. 2 of 1930 and other legislative acts and local laws not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

This Local Law shall take effect January 1, 1941.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Delaney, Golden, Behan and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative. CARRIED.
