LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1957.

ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1957, IN THIS INSTANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTION INSPECTORS, CUSTODIANS OF VOTING MACHINES AND PARTY REPRESENTATIVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. SECTION I OF LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1957, IS HEREBY AMENDED SO THAT THE PROVISIONS RELATING TO COMPENSATION SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

INSPECTORS OF ELECTION AND OTHER ELECTION OFFICERS ENTITLED TO BE APPOINTED SHALL RECEIVE COMPENSATION, WHICH IS HEREBY FIXED AS FOLLOWS: PRIMARY DAY - \$15.00; EACH REGISTRATION DAY - \$15.00; AND GENERAL ELECTION DAY - \$15.00; PARTY REPRESENTATIVES FOR ELECTION, ENTITLED TO BE APPOINTED, SHALL RECEIVE THE SUM OF \$10.00 FOR GENERAL ELECTION DAY; CUSTODIANS OF VOTING MACHINES SHALL RECEIVE \$100.00 FOR THEIR SERVICES FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR.

SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.

ON ROLL CALL, ALDERMEN HOLLAND, BRAULT, DAME, JABAUT, AND CORODIMAS VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE; NO ONE IN THE NEGATIVE, (ALDERMAN FLYNN BEING ABSENT) CARRIED.
