LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1972

A LOCAL LAW amending Local Law No. 3 of 1952 with respect to the time for conducting a referendum on a bond resolution or capital note resolution.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Local Law No. 3 of 1952 is hereby amended to read as follows: "SECTION 2. Whenever the Common Council shall adopt a bond resolution or capital note resolution exceeding the amount of \$250,000.00, it shall, at the same meeting, by resolution, provide for a referendum thereon, to be held not less than thirty calendar days after the date of such meeting."

SECTION 2. Section 3 of Local Law No. 3 of 1952 is hereby amended to read as follows: "SECTION 3. The hours during which the referendum shall be held shall be as provided in the provisions of the City Charter relating to special elections, or during the hours provided for in any general election."

On roll call, Aldermen Burke, Dame, Branon, Rennell, Griffin and Poitras voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; CARRIED.
