LOCAL LAW NO. 8 of 1945.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend the Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, in relation to the power of the Common Council to transfer surplus moneys from one fund to another prior to the close of any fiscal year.


Section 1. Section forty-two of Chapter two hundred sixty-nine of the Laws of Nineteen Hundred Two, entitled "An Act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh", is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 42. SUBDIVISION OF FUNDS: The Common Council shall subdivide the funds of the City, as established by this act, and the City Chamberlain shall restate his account of the funds so subdivided accordingly. Before the close of the fiscal year, the Common Council may transfer moneys from any fund in which there is a surplus, except the school fund, to other fund or funds in their discretion.

Section 2. This local ^{Law} ~~Act~~ shall take effect immediately after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary and Spinks voted in the affirmative; Alderman Tyrell voting in the negative,
CARRIED.
