LOCAL LAW NO. 8 of 1967

A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED AN ACT ABOLISHING THE BEACH COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, AND VESTING ALL ITS POWERS IN THE COMMON COUNCIL.

The Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, does hereby enact as follows:

SECTION 1 The Beach Commission of the City of Plattsburgh, as organized under the provisions of Local Law No. 5 of 1966, is hereby abolished, and all the powers and duties held by said Commission are hereby vested in the Common Council, including, but not limiting, the control of all funds and monies now held by the said Beach Commission in a Beach Fund or otherwise, and the said Common Council shall have all the powers granted by all laws, both general and special, in respect to the same. And it is hereby authorized to conduct said Beach as a Department of the City Government, to be known as the Municipal Beach Department, and to employ such officers and employees as may be necessary to operate the same within the limits of all statutes applicable thereto.

SECTION 2: This Act shall not be construed so as to affect the validity of any contract entered into by said Beach Commission, and now presently in force.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 3}}\colon$ This Act shall take effect after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Booth, King, Duken, Sabourin and Coffey voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; (Alderman Rougeau being absent) CARRIED.
