**RESOLUTION TITLE: AUTHORIZE ONE-YEAR EXTENSION FOR EXISTING CONTRACT #WRRF 2022-03: LABORATORY SERVICES FOR THE WATER RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Water Resource Recovery Facility (WRRF) contracts professional laboratory services for the analyses of various wastewaters, hauled wastes, sludges, leachates, and groundwater samples in accordance with the requirements set forth by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA), and New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYS DEC); and,

**WHEREAS**, a one-year contract renewal approval was received on December 2, 2022;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:** The Common Council agrees to extend “LABORATORY SERVICES FOR THE WATER RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY CONTRACT #WRRF 2022-03” for Phoenix Environmental Laboratories, Inc., in the estimated amount of \$22,714.00 (additionally an agreed upon Low-Level Mercury price increase). The contract period shall be for one (1) year, commencing on April 1, 2023, and may be extended for two (2) additional one-year terms, upon mutual agreement.
