Host Community Agreement <u>City of Plattsburgh & Adirondack Coast Visitors Bureau</u> And American Bass Anglers, Inc.

Agreement between the <u>City of Plattsburgh & Adirondack Coast Visitors Bureau</u>, 7061 State <u>Route 9 Plattsburgh New York</u> and American Bass Anglers, Inc. (ABA), P.O. Box 475, Athens, AL; 35612.

Whereas, the <u>City of Plattsburgh & Adirondack Coast Visitors Bureau</u> (Host") is desirous of hosting and promoting a Bass Pro Shop Open Series tournament (the "Tournament") on Lake Champlain.

Whereas, ABA, is desirous of conducting and promoting a Bass Pro Shops Open Series bass tournament on Lake Champlain.

Whereas, the parties desire to enter into an agreement concerning responsibilities in relation to said tournament, Anticipated attendance of 100 boat and 200 anglers.

Now therefore, the parties hereto do hereby agree and covenant as follows:

Host Community Responsibilities:

- a) Adirondack Coast Visitors Bureau shall pay ABA the sum of \$2000.00 to be paid within five (5) days after the conclusion of the Tournament.
- b) Provide a meeting room acceptable to ABA at no charge for the Tournament registration and briefing. (Crete Civic Center if available)
- c) Use of the Plattsburgh City Marina parking lot and designated docks for the 2 days of the tournament and set up on September 25th.
- d) Up to two (2) complimentary hotel rooms for a minimum of two (2) nights. Arrival/and departure dates determined by ABA. (Friday sept 25 and Saturday sept 26)

Neither party hereto is agent; employee or servant of the other, and this contract is made for the sole purpose of establishing the division of responsibilities in connection with the Tournament and does not in any manner create a partnership between the parties hereto.

RIGHT OF ENTRY PROPERTY LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this ____th day of February, 2020 by and between Saranac Power Partners, L.P. having an address of 99 Weed Street, Plattsburgh, New York, 12901 ("SPP"), and the City of Plattsburgh, having an address of 41 City Hall Place, Plattsburgh, New York 12901 (the "City") are collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of certain real property, including a right of way, for the public roadway known as Weed Street, which provides access to the property owned by SPP ("License Area").

WHEREAS, SPP desires to enter the License Area to install and maintain a Stop Sign and other traffic control devices in order to enhance the safety and vehicular operation of vehicles as the utilize the License Area in order to access the property owned by SPP (hereafter "Traffic Control Work"). The intent is for SPP to install a Stop Sign approximately 100 feet from the SPP entrance Gate off Weed Street to allow sufficient time for delivery trucks to safely navigate this area and enter the SPP property.

WHEREAS, SPP and the City desire to enter into this Agreement so that SPP and its agents can enter the License Area and perform the Traffic Control Work.

WHEREAS, SPP will be responsible for paying and compensating employees, agents or subcontractors for the requested Traffic Control Work and the City will have no responsibility to make any payment or compensation to any employee, agent or subcontractor of SPP for the Traffic Control Work.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties intending to be legally bound hereby agree as follows:

1. Rights Granted

Subject to compliance by SPP of its obligations under this Agreement, as well as compliance with the laws, rules and regulations of the State of New York, the City hereby grants to SPP a revocable, non-exclusive license ("License") to enter the License Area for the sole purpose of performing the Traffic Control Work. Specifically, the City grants SPP permission to install and maintain a Stop Sign approximately 100 feet to the south of the SPP entrance gate. SPP will be exclusively responsible for paying and compensating any employee, agent or subcontractor for the Traffic Control Work, including the purchase of any traffic control devices. The City will not pay any fee, invoice, or other consideration to SPP, its agents, employees or subcontractors for the Traffic Control Work.

2. Nonexclusive of License

The License granted hereunder is nonexclusive. The City continues to own, maintain and control the License Area.

The License granted hereunder is made subject and subordinate to the prior and continuing rights and obligations of the City, its successors and assigns to use the License Area.

3. Term of License

Term. The License granted herein ("License") shall commence on February __, 2020 and shall continue without termination date, unless either Party, in their sole discretion, cancels, annuls or revokes the License. Either party may terminate and revoke this License upon fourteen (14) days' written notice in the sole discretion of either party. If this License is terminated, SPP will promptly remove any Traffic Control devices it has installed.

4. Entry

SPP shall (1) provide the City with no less than two (2) days' prior written notice of Licensee's entry on the License Area and also obtain the City's written permission for the specific location and design of any Traffic Control Devices, (2) perform the Traffic Control Work in a good and workmanlike manner in compliance with all applicable laws and professional standards which govern the installation of traffic control devices, (3) return the site to a natural and non-hazardous condition, (4) prior to entering the License Area, deliver to the City evidence that SPP or its contractor has no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate for bodily injury, including death, and property damage, and naming the City as an additional insured, and (4) indemnify and hold the city harmless for any claim, injury, or action which accrues as a result of the Traffic Control Work performed under this License.

5. Governing Law

The rights and liability of the parties under this license shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York.

6. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the complete agreement between the parties and supersedes any prior agreements, whether written or oral, concerning the subject of this Agreement.

7. Relationship

The parties intend by this Agreement to establish the relationship of licensee and licensor only, and do not intend to create a partnership, joint venture, joint enterprise, or any business relationship other than that of licensee and licensor. In the event there is a dispute between SPP and any of its agents, subcontractors or employees regarding the payment or compensation for any work performed in the License Area, then SPP agrees to not place any lien on the License Area or make any claim against the City of Plattsburgh for payment or compensation.

8. Invalidity of Provisions

If any term or provision of this Agreement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such term or provision to persons whose circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected thereby.

9. Service of Notice

Notices hereunder shall be in writing signed by the party serving the same and shall be sent by Registered or Certified United States Mail, Return Receipt Requested, restricted delivery, postage prepaid, and (a) and (b) if intended for the City, shall be addressed to:

Saranac Power Partners, LP Attn: John Gokey 99 Weed Street Plattsburgh, NY 12901 Or to such other address as either party may have furnished to the other as a place for the service of notice. Any notice so mailed shall be deemed to have been given as of the time said notice is deposited in the United States mail.

10. No Assignment Permitted

The rights hereby granted are granted to SPP, only and SPP shall have no right to assign any of its rights under this Agreement.

11. Amendments

No waivers, alterations or modifications of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing, duly executed by both SPP and the City.
