Between

Clinton County Department of Planning and Clinton County Public Transit (CCPT) 135 Margaret Street, Suite 124 Plattsburgh, NY 12901

And

City of Plattsburgh, New York 41 City Hall Place Plattsburgh, NY 12901

1. Purpose:

The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is to establish a formal mechanism for payment by Clinton County Public Transit (CCPT) to the City of Plattsburgh, New York Department of Public Works for the removal of obsolete bus stop signs.

2. Authority:

Authority to enter into this agreement comes from the County of Clinton, New York Legislature and the City of Plattsburgh, New York Common Council.

3. CCPT agrees to:

- a. Provide information to the City of Plattsburgh Department of Public Works about CCPT signs which are within City of Plattsburgh rights-of-way and which are in need of removal.
- b. Upon receipt of invoice, arrange for payment by the County of Clinton to the City of Plattsburgh in the amount of \$40 per sign removed.
- c. Promptly and effectively cooperate with the City of Plattsburgh Department of Public Works in resolving any problems that may arise.
- 4. The City of Plattsburgh Department of Public Works agrees to:
 - a. At the convenience of the City of Plattsburgh Department of Public Works, when weather and labor availability allow, remove CCPT signs identified by CCPT as needing removal.
 - b. Following the removal of one or more signs, provide an invoice to CCPT which identifies the signs removed and charges \$40 per sign.
 - c. Promptly and effectively cooperate with CCPT in resolving any problems that may arise.
